Elmer Little League Majors All-Star Selection Procedure

The purpose of this procedure is to provide a process for selecting the majors All-Star teams. The primary goal is include a "Parent Vote". The Vice Presidents and majors coordinators are responsible for coordinating the All-Star selection.

- 1. Towards the end of the season, the Vice Presidents of Baseball/Softball will email a survey "ballot" to each family (one ballot per child at that level).
- 2. The parents will then have 48 hours to select 6 players from their team that they deem worthy of consideration to represent Elmer Little League on the 10-12 year old All-Star Team. *Note, age of team may vary if there are 2 majors All Star teams.
- 3. Incomplete ballots or ballots submitted after the 48 hour deadline will be void.
- 4. The Vice Presidents of Baseball/Softball will tabulate the votes and present the list of nominees to the majors coaches at the All-Star selection meeting.
- 5. The Vice Presidents will let the coaches know the number of votes each player received.
- 6. The coaches will review the list of nominees, and select 10 players for the 10-12 year old All-Star team. *Note, age of team may vary if there are 2 majors All-Star teams.
 - a. Players must have played a minimum of 8 regular season games to qualify for All-Star selection. Proof of attendance may be required to ensure qualification.
- 7. The All-Star manager will fill out the roster as he/she deems fit. They may use the list of nominees from the parent vote, or choose players at his/her discretion.
 - a. The All-Star manager is the manager of the team with the most wins during regular season.
- 8. If there is to be a younger Majors All-Star team (either 8-10 or 9-11), the coaches will choose that team. They may take the nominees from the parent vote under consideration if there are any players that fall within the age requirements of that team.

Note: The Vice Presidents reserve the right to remove players from All Star selection based on their behaviors during regular season.
