### **Majors All Stars Voting discussion/determination:**

Revising the process for voting for All-Stars at the Majors level for this year was discussed. The initial proposal was to allow the kids to vote for who they thought should be named to the 10-12 year old team. After much discussion, it was eventually decided to go in a different direction, and instead, allow the parents to vote. Keep in mind, they are voting for the players they think should be considered for the 10-12 year old team. Ultimately, the team will be formed by the Coaches.

Beginning this season, Elmer Little League is expanding the All-Star voting process at the Majors Baseball/Softball level to include a "Parent Vote". Here's how it works:

1. Towards the end of the season, the VP of Baseball/Softball will email a survey "ballot" to each family (one ballot per child at that level).
2. The parents will then have 48 hours to select 6 players from *their team* that they deem worthy of consideration to represent Elmer Little League on the 10-12 year old All-Star Team.
3. Incomplete ballots or ballots submitted after the 48 hour deadline will be void.
4. The VP of Baseball/Softball will tabulate the votes and present the list of nominees to the Majors Coaches at the All-Star selection meeting.
5. The VP will let the Coaches know the number of votes each player received.

6. The Coaches will review the list of nominees, and select 10 players for the 10-12 year old All-Star team.
7. The All-Star Manager will fill out the roster as he/she deems fit. They may use the list of nominees from the parent vote, or choose players at his/her discretion.
8. If there is to be a younger Majors All-Star team (either 8-10 or 9-11), the Coaches will choose that team. They may take the nominees from the parent vote under consideration if there are any players that fall within the age requirements of that team.
